



OLYMPIC COUNCIL OF ASIA

Decisions
41st OCA General Assembly
4th October 2022 - Phnom Penh, Cambodia

1. All the 44 recognized member NOCs of OCA attended the meeting
2. The OCA Award of Merit was presented to the following delegates for their outstanding contribution to Asian Olympic Movement:
 - i) Dr. Thong Kahn, President NOC of Cambodia
 - ii) Mr. Tran Van Manh, Secretary General NOC of Vietnam
3. The Sheikh Fahad - Hiroshima Sports Science Award was presented to:
 - i) Dr. Dilip Chaturanga Ranasinghe from Sri Lanka
 - ii) Dr. Marcus Lee from Singapore.
4. The 2029 Asian Winter Games were awarded to the City of Trojena, Neom, Saudi Arabia and Host City Contract signed with the NOC of Saudi Arabia and the City of Trojena.
5. Reports of the Vice Presidents were received with appreciation and approved unanimously.
6. The report of the Thailand 6th Asian Indoor and Martial Art Games Organizing Committee was received with appreciation. The house unanimously approved the holding of the Coordination Committee on 14th and 15th of November 2022.
7. The report of the Hangzhou 19th Asian Games Organizing Committee was received with appreciation by the house and the new dates of 23rd September to 8th October 2023 for holding the games were unanimously approved. The house also approved the Key dates for the Games.
8. Report of the City for hosting the 2025 Asian Indoor and Martial Art Games and the 2034 Asian Games were received with appreciation by the house.

9. The report of Aichi Nagoya 20th Asian Games Organizing Committee was received with appreciation by the house

10. The report of Doha 21st Asian Games Organizing Committee was received with appreciation by the house.

11. The reports of the Chairs of the Standing Committees were received with appreciation and approved unanimously by the house. The house also unanimously approved: -

- a) Holding of the Athletes Forum in Bangkok in March/April 2023
- b) Establishment of OCA Sub Office for Culture & Education in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.
- c) Formation of the Asian Mixed Martial Arts Association with Mr. Gordon Tang as its President
- d) Not to allow Sheikh Talal Mohammad Al Sabah, President Asian Bowling Federation (ABF) to participate in any OCA events or Asian Games. Bowling will continue to be part of the Asian Indoor and Martial Art Games.
- e) The internal and external audit reports and annual audited financial statements for the year ended 31st December 2021 for OCA and Olympic Solidarity
- f) The appointment of Moore Stephs - Kuwait as the internal auditors for OCA and approved the internal audit reports as at 30.6.2022
- g) Authorized the Director General OCA to take all appropriate measures (legal or otherwise) to protect the interest of OCA from the breach of trust and contract by Tissot, the OCA Timing and Scoring Partners.
- h) Create and investment office in Singapore.
- i) The new marketing standards of the OCA.
- j) to appoint Dr. Kamal Hadidi as the Co-Chair of the Anti-Doping Commission.
- k) The Articles on the Asian Games in the Constitution should be converted into *Bye-laws*. This will enable any amendments in the future to accommodate the changes. This is exactly done by the IOC for the Olympic Games in the Olympic Charter.
- l) There cannot be two members in the OCA Executive Board from the same country except from the Asian Games Host Country.

m) In consultation with IOC, the Boxing event in the Asian Games will be considered as a qualification for the Olympic Games. Therefore, the TDs for Boxing will be nominated by the IOC,


12. The Olympic Solidarity update as presented by Mr. Olivier Niamkey and Mr. Jerome Poivey as well as the OCA Continental Programme updates were unanimously approved by the house.

13. The ANOC update as presented by Mrs. Gunilla Lindberg was received with appreciation by the house.

14. The house received with appreciation and unanimously approved the announcement made by Mr. Ali Al-Marri, Dy. Secretary General, Kuwait Olympic Committee (KOC) that if Sheikh Ahmad Al-Fahad Al-Sabah is cleared by the courts then he will return as President of the OCA. If he is unsuccessful, then Mr. Husain Al-Musallam, SG KOC and present Director General of OCA will be the official candidate of the KOC for the President of OCA for the period 2023-2027. KOC also reconfirmed their commitment to hosting the OCA headquarters in Kuwait, which they have been doing with great commitment for over 4 decades. There was no objection from any NOC to this announcement.

15. The house authorized the President OCA to finalise the date and place of the next General Assembly and inform all concerned.
